Billing Policy Update

Starting January 2019 the billing date will be changing. Statements will be sent out on the 1st of the month and the due date will be the 10th of the current billing statement month, i.e. Jan. 1st 2019 statements will go out and the statement due date will be January 10th 2019 (all EFT billing will run on this date as well).

We will also be having a small dues increase in 2019. If you still wish to prepay you have until the 25th of December to do so. You will get the old rate until then. You must pay by check or cash to get this benefit. If you do not make the deadline you will have to wait until January to pay for the year at the new rates. We will be sending the new rates out soon.
